

Artists, we're extending the application deadline for *Masked*, a touring visual arts exhibition featuring Vermont artists with disabilities.

You now have until September 7th to apply.

We invite Vermont visual artists with disabilities to apply for <u>Masked</u>, an exhibition of works to travel <u>statewide through April 2023</u>. The exhibition will begin its statewide tour in early January 2022. <u>Applications are due by September 7, 2021</u>.



Artists are asked to submit works that represent their interpretation of the theme of *Masked*. Like

many words, "masked" has nuanced and layered meanings. Inclusive Arts Vermont encourages artists to interpret the theme and its meaning as broadly as it takes to inspire their creativity.

Masked offers participating artists opportunities to be featured in statewide publicity, remote and in-person programs, build larger audiences for their work, and participate in artist networking events with other Vermont artists with disabilities.
