### Adaptive Aerial Class Series

[Adaptive Aerial invites kids ages 7-12](#) with and without disabilities to explore a new way of moving with the invigorating support of aerial fabrics.

Aerial dance uses fabrics hung from the ceiling to explore movement in relation with gravity. In Adaptive Aerial, participants are invited to explore a new way of moving with the invigorating support of aerial fabric. Teaching artists Nicole and Toby create a safe and supportive community to encourage and celebrate our collective creativity as we explore how we can hang, spin, pull, push, and rest our bodies in relation to the fabric. All are welcome.



Teachers will provide a broad range of options to safely approach aerial techniques. The structure of the class will support students as they move at their own pace toward individual goals. We'll celebrate our creativity and growth with a group showing at the end of the session.

This class is an inclusive class for children with and without disabilities.

We take Covid-19 precautions seriously. Masks are required for all participants, family, visitors, and staff. The studio is equipped with air filters. Please follow all current CDC and state guidance and do not attend class if you are unwell. Please note that physical distancing measures will be practiced, but we will use hands-on spotting if necessary for safety.

### Inclusive Arts Integration for Families

Families learning at home, integrate the arts into your curriculum while building a creative, supportive, and inclusive learning community. Fall sessions run from October 18th through December 6th.

### [Session for 5-8 year olds](#)

- Time: Monday 3:00pm - 4:00pm
- Topic: Patterns in Nature
- Subjects Integrated: Science, Math, the Arts

In this inclusive arts integration class, students will explore color, shape, repetition, form, and patterns in nature and art. Math and science concepts will be woven into arts learning.



### [Session for 9-12 year olds](#)

- Time: Mondays, 4:15pm - 5:15pm
- Topics: Properties of Light & Fluid Dynamics
- Subjects Integrated: Science & the Arts

In this inclusive arts integration class, students will explore two topics in science learning through experimentations in art projects.



For both sessions, students can expect to engage in art making, sharing/showing art, in addition to connecting with a teaching artist and other learners. Classes will meet on Zoom once a week for live art making, sharing, and conversation. Students will be encouraged to work on their projects in between classes as well. A list of materials will be provided to families after registration is complete.

Both sessions are Pay What You Can. Students should plan to attend the entire 8-week session.
