

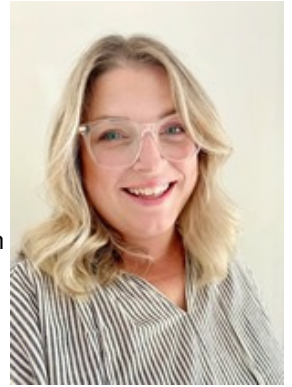
Hello friends,
